PARAPROFESSIONAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

ONE of the following requirements are required to be eligible for a paraprofessional position:

- Hold an Associate’s degree or Higher.
 - Earned 60 College Semester hours - grade “C” or better for courses; Remedial/learning support courses are not creditable.
 - Earned 90 Quarter hours - grade “C” or better for courses; Remedial/learning support courses are not creditable.
 - Passed the GACE Paraprofessional Assessment **and** must have earned at least a high school diploma or GED
 - GACE PARAPROFESSIONAL PASSING SCORE: 250 or higher
- If you have met one of the abovementioned requirements, you will need to provide documentation to verify that you qualify for the position. You can upload unofficial transcripts or GACE testing results to your application.
- Once you are hired for a paraprofessional position, you will need to request official college transcripts to be sent to the Newton County School System Human Resources Department.
- The school system must apply for your paraprofessional certificate. A paraprofessional application can only be requested once you have obtained a paraprofessional position. An application will be given or sent to you for you to complete and return to the Human Resources Dept.

PARAPROFESSIONAL ASSESSMENT FEES TEST PREPARATION INFORMATION

The test fee for the GACE® Paraprofessional assessment is \$38 and is non-refundable.

Prometric Test Center and At Home Appointments test fee is \$68 / Reschedule fee \$34

Payment must be made through the administering school district, Regional Education Service Agency (RESA), or other agencies. Ask about accepted forms of payment when you contact them for test availability. All test fees must be paid in full and in U.S. dollars. Your test site will be able to walk you through the necessary steps for payment. Note that some test sites may charge an additional fee over the \$38 test fee.
